Greetings from VOICE Philippines!

VOICE Phils. (for Values Orientation in Classroom Education) is a non-sectarian, PCNC-accredited (for Philippine Council for NGO Certification) national NGO whose advocacy is to inculcate God-based values to the younger generation. In line with the Constitution and the Moral Recovery Program of the government, VOICE has collaborated with DepEd in teaching supplemental Godly values instruction classes (VICs) at no cost to the government for more than 11 years now. Presently VICs are taught in 18 regions, in 74 out of 81 provinces nationwide, teaching around 300,000 students weekly in more than 1,000 public and private schools.

We are writing this letter to officially request your kind office for permission that the trained volunteer teachers from our community groups be allowed to continue teaching VICs in the schools of your Division. The VOICE program will certainly benefit the schools and their students especially since the program has been recently selected by DepEd NCR Region as **"Outstanding Literacy Program"** for 2016 and is currently vying for the national title.

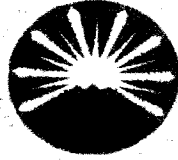
