FIRST DIVISION TECHNOLYMPICS

To: OIC, Assistant Superintendents Education Supervisors/Coordinators Secondary School Heads

- 1. With reference to Regional Memorandum No. 59, s. 2013, the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) shall conduct the 2013 National Festival of Talents consisting of skills exhibition in the different fields where the Technolympics is one of the areas to be competed on April 7-10, 2013 at Tacloban City.
- 2. In this connection, this Office announces the conduct of the First Division Technolympics on February 22-23, 2013 at Daanbantayan National High School, Daanbantayan, Cebu. The said undertaking will be jointly hosted by the public high schools in the municipality.
- 3. The Division Technolympics will showcase performances in the different skills acquired by students in the various specializations of TLE and TVE. It is open to all from 1st to 4th year students enrolled in both public and private high schools. A participant may join only one (1) event.
- 4. Each municipality shall identify the participants per skill as specified in the contest packages which were given to the municipal TLE coordinators. Search for Mr. & Miss Technolympics will be done to highlight the affair.
- 5. The sheet containing the general guidelines of the competition is attached as enclosure No. 2.
- 6. Teachers who will be involved in this undertaking will be given one (1) day service credit.
- 7. Travelling and other incidental expenses incurred by the contest administrators, coordinators and Division TLE/TVE officers shall be chargeable against school MOOE/STEP/PTA/SEF funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

8. Wide and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

GENERAL GUIDELINES OF THE COMPETITION

A. REQUIREMENTS

Each of the contestants is required to submit the following credentials a day before the contest.

- 1. Certified photocopy of Form 137-A with the second grading grades
- Certification of the contestant's enrolment during the present school year by the school head
- 3. Recent 2x2 picture attached to Form 137-A
- 4. Original school identification card
- 5. School uniform

 \mathcal{NOTE} : All the first five (5) requirements shall be placed inside the long brown envelope

labeled with the:

- Name of the contestant
- Skill to be participated
- Name of coach
- Name of municipality
- Name of school
- Name of school head/administrator

The trainers are required to submit the following documents to the division credential in-charge for submission to the Regional Credentials Committee

- 1. Certified photocopy of the trainer's appointment from the civil service
- 2. Certified photocopy of the trainer's service record
- 3. Recent 2x2 picture attached to the service record
- 4. Certification signed by the school head on his assignment as trainer
- 5. Official ID

B. REGISTRATION

- 1. Participants (esp. from far schools) can be at the venue in the afternoon a day before (Feb 21). Solidarity meeting of all coaches will be at 9:00 a.m. and the opening program will be at 10:30 a.m. Contest proper will start at exactly 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon of Feb 22.
- 2. The approved registration is 150 per participant and it shall be in cash. Checks will NOT be accepted.

C. PARTICIPANTS

All participants shall wear their uniform and ID's for the entire duration of the contest. Contest administrators/coordinators are required to wear their contest ID during the contest proper. Contestants shall participate in only one (1) skill contest.

D. MEALS AND SNACKS

Foods and snacks of the participants shall be provided by each delegation.

E. BILLETING

Rooms for the delegation shall be provided by the host school. Occupants of the room shall maintain the cleanliness of the room and its surroundings and shall clean the room and return things used in its proper place before leaving.

F. JUDGING THE SKILL CONTEST

- 1. Judging shall be based on the criteria per skill contest.
- 2. Issues/questions/concerns raised during the contest shall not be entertained.
- 3. Coaches are not allowed to stay in the contest area while the contest is in progress.
- 4. Before finalizing the over-all results, the members of the board of judges shall be given time to discuss and deliberate the results.
- 5. Decision of the judges is final. However, judges shall be required to discuss the contestants on the items that need to be improved. Suggestions to improve on the weak points should be emphasized.

G. ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS/AWARDING

This will be done during the Search for Mr. & Miss Technolympics.
