RATIONALE

As BIT International College celebrates the golden wedding anniversary of its founders, Atty. Dionisio D. Balite, Ph.D. and Dr. Lilia Ancog-Balite, Ph.D. the institution is extending its scholarship grants to all incoming first year college students and transferees this June, 2013.

COVERAGE

ALL HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES OF MARCH, 2013 AND TRANSFEREES

GUIDELINES:

- 1. Grantee must be in the list of graduates of March, 2013.
- 2. Grantees need not to apply with the Buhing Inambitay ug Tinabangay Foundation as well as in the renewal thereof.
- 3. Hereunder is the scheme of the discount effective first semester, 2013-2014.
 - A. For schools with graduates of 50 and above

Ranking	Discount on Tuition Fee
1 st -5 th Place	100 %
6 th -10 th Place	90 %
11 th -15 th Place	80 %
16 th -20 th Place	70 %
21 st -25 th Place	60 %
26 th Place-below	50 %

B. For schools with less than 50 graduates

Ranking	Discount on Tuition Fee
1 st -3 rd Place	100 %
4 th -6 th Place	90 %
7 th – 9 th Place	80 %
10 th -12 th Place	70 %
13 st -15 th Place	60 %
16 th Place-below	50 %

C. For TRANSFEREES: 50 % Tuition Fee Discount in all courses except the Graduate, Post Graduate and Law Programs.

4. On the succeeding semesters, the grantee must qualify for the same grant with the following grade requirement based on the computed GWA of the previous semester:

GWA		Discount on Tuition Fee
1.00 -1.300	(95% - 93%)	100 %
1.301-1.500	(92.9%-90%)	90 %
1.501-1.700	(89.9%-88%)	80 %
1.701-1.900	(87.9%-86%)	70 %
1.901-2.000	(85.9%-85%)	60 %
Passing Grade	(84.9%-below)	50 %

In case the grantee cannot maintain the grade, but is still qualified to the next lower level, he/she can avail of the discount equivalent to his/her current GWA. Grantees incurring failing and incomplete grades shall automatically lose his privilege.

- 5. The discount is based on the curricular academic load of the course as shown in the checklist of her/his chosen course. During summer classes, the grantee can avail if there is summer load in his curricular academic load.
- 6. In case of transfer, **NO** monetary obligation is imposed on the grantee with the school like payback of the discount enjoyed during his stay. But if the grantee reenrolls, he can no longer enjoy the privilege under the grant.
- 7. If the grantee drops or stop studying, he can still avail of his privilege upon reenrollment until graduation of the course he enrolled subject to the provision in number 4 hereof.
- 8. If the student shifts to another course, he can still avail the grant's privilege.
- Certification of grades that grantee has no incomplete and failing grades and the rosters of grantees are the bases for the award of the grant of the succeeding semester until graduation.
- 10. Recipient of the Buhing Inambitay ug Tinabangay Foundation scholarship program cannot avail of this grant at the same time and in his succeeding semester of his study.
- 11. Grantee is mandated to attend an Orientation program for proper guidance. His loyalty to the BIT IC is expected.
- 12. Failure to conform with the above guidelines shall lose his privilege.
