DEPED-CNU-RBI SUMMER TRAINING COURSE FOR TEACHERS OF LEARNERS WITH VISUAL IMPAIRMENT

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Officers –in-Charge of the Regular Divisions

- 1. The Department of Education(DEPED), in coordination with the Cebu Normal University(CNU) and the Resources for the Blind (RBI) inc., announces the Summer Training Course for Teachers of Learners with Visual Impairment. The training will be conducted at the Cebu Normal University, Osmeña Blvd., Cebu City on April 10 to May 6, 2013.
- 2. Selected recipient divisions of the scholarship program have to commend a teacher who meets the following qualifications:
 - Has taken a Bachelor's degree related to the area of scholarship with a grade point average of not lower than 2/B/85
 - Has been a teacher for at least three years under permanent status with a Performance Rating of at least Very Satisfactory (VS)
 - Not more than 45 years old
 - Has no pending administrative case and /or criminal record
 - Has been certified by a government physician to be physically and mentally fit and not pregnant during the scholarship period
 - Has not availed of any scholarship /training for at least two (2) years
 - Has possessed leadership potential, facilitation skills, positive attitude to mentor or coach other teachers in his /her school/division as necessary
 - · Has developed relevant re-entry plan
 - Has identified at least 3 visually impaired children in his/her community.
- 3. Enclosed is the list of priority areas for your reference and revised list of scholars to return this summer 2013. - 5. Second and Third Batch Scholars have been chosen to return to DEPED-CNU-RBI Summer Training Course for teachers of learners with visual impairment. Below is other important information regarding the training.
 - Course Dates: The course will begin on April 10, 2013 and continue until May 6, 2013. Scholars should arrive in Cebu not later than April 10, 2013 for registration from 8:00 am to 12:00 noon.
 - Travel Guidelines: All participants are requested to travel by bus or by boat, economy class. Upgrading may be done at the expense of participants.
 - Travel Reimbursements: Actual major transportation expenses shall be reimbursed upon submission of receipts.
 - Accommodation: The Department of Education and Resources for the Blind will provide the trainees a stipend of Php. 8,500.00 for materials, and board and lodging.
 - **Pertinent Papers:** Trainees are required to submit the duly accomplished scholarship contract prior to enrolment and program implementation narrative report.
