- 5. Participants are expected to arrive in the venue a day before or on time for the training. They are expected to attend the first day of the training.
- 6. The Chinese participants' travelling and other incidental expenses which shall be reimbursed upon presentation of complete travel documents (authority to travel, official receipts, bus/plane/boat tickets, terminal fee tickets, boarding pass) shall be chargeable against School MOOE, while their accommodation and meals as well as the French participants' transportation, meals, and other incidental expenses are chargeable to DepEd Human Resource and Training Development (DepEd HRTD) Funds, subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations. The partner institutions in said foreign languages shall cover training fees.
- 7. School principals are enjoined to purchase a set of reference and activity book needed by the teachers in the training which can also be used in teaching the students such as "Alter Ego 2" for the French Course, chargeable against School MOOE, subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
