Greetings!

Children's Legal Bureau Inc. with finding support from Terre des Hommes-Neiherlands, has been conducting training on Personal Safety Lessons twice for selected teachers from our CRPU areas in Balamban, Compostela and Naga, Cebu. First training was conducted last July 20-23, 2011, this was followed by a Trainors Training on April 2-5, 2013. These two activities were facilitated by a training team—from CRPU areas of Minglanitia, Lapulapu City and one from DepEd regional office.

On August 20-23, 2013, CLB in cooperation with our funding partner, will organize again another set of training on Personal Safety Lessons (PSL) for the teachers of our Child's Rights Protection Units in expansion areas namely Argao, Moalboal and Toledo City. It aims to equip teachers with necessary skills, knowledge & new teaching techniques in the context of Child Abuse Prevention in schools and communities. Target participants are teachers from primary and secondary school. We will be coordinating with the DepEd superintendents/supervisors in the locality for identifying the best participants to attend.

The training is live-in, and will be held at the Applied Nutrition Center, Baniad, Cebu City. Food and accommodation are for free, however, transportation expenses of the participants shall serve as local counterpart.

Again, we would like to ask permission from your good office to allow the PSL trainers/facilitators and target participants from CRPU areas mentioned above to conduct and participate in the upcoming PSL training.

Looking forward to your continuing support for the welfare of our poor children.
