GUIDELINES FOR THE SEARCH FOR 2013 OUTSTANDING SPED TEACHERS

- 1. The Search is open to all teachers of children with hearing impairment, visual impairment, intellectual disability, autism spectrum disorder, learning disability and mental giftedness.
- 2. SPED teachers who have won FIRST place in national special education teacher competitions are not eligible for nomination.
- 3. Screening of nominees shall be done in three levels following the schedule below. The Division Screening Committee shall be composed of the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, Division Supervisor-In-Charge of SPED and one Supervisor-In-Charge of any learning area. The Regional Screening Committee shall be composed of the Assistant Regional Director, Chief of the Elementary Education Division and the Regional Supervisor-In-Charge of SPED.

- Documents of nominees shall be screened and ranked according to the selection. Only ONE

 Regional Winner for each category should be submitted to the DepED Central Office, hence, there shall be no ties.
- 5. The required documents of the regional winners (First Placers only) shall be submitted to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, 2/F Bonifacio Bidg., DepED Complex, Meralco Ave., 1600 Pasig City on or before August 16, 2013.
- All documents of regional winners must be authenticated by proper authorities, compiled and arranged according to the criteria. The compilation of documents shall include a table of contents with the Nomination Form as the first page.
- 7. Final screening will be done by an independent body. The decision of the National Screening Committee shall be final.
- 8. The Regional and National Winners shall be given Plaques of Recognition and cash awards.
