### 2013 NATIONAL LITERACY CONFERENCE

- 1. In celebration of the annual Literacy Week as stipulated in Presidential Proclamation No. 239 entitled Declaring the Period from September 2 to 8 of Every Year as Literacy Week, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Literacy Coordinating Council (LCC), in cooperation and coordination with other government organizations (GOs), local government units (LGUs), private organizations (POs) and non-government organizations (NGOs), will hold the 2013 National Literacy Conference with the theme Literacy for Inclusive Growth on September 2-6, 2013 (inclusive of travel time) at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
- 2. Literacy is a responsibility of all. It is envisioned that at the end of the conference, the participants will be able to:
  - a. understand the K to 12 or the Enhanced Basic Education Program in relation to different modes of learning;
  - b. understand social media landscape and its effectiveness in message delivery;
  - c. promote partnership between the local school board and the local literacy implementing units; and
  - d. utilize learning to create and generate jobs towards achieving economic growth and development.
- The following participants are expected to attend the conference:

## Department of Education (DepEd)

- a. Bureau, center, and regional directors or their representatives;
   bureau/regional chiefs and assistant chiefs; and regional supervisors of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) and Formal Education;
- b. Schools division/city schools superintendents and assistant superintendents, division supervisors of ALS and Formal Education, district supervisors and principals/head teachers of elementary and secondary from both public and private schools, ALS coordinators and mobile teachers especially those from 4th, 5th and 6th Class municipalities/districts and provinces. Participants from this Department shall attend on official business.

# Other Government and Non-government Agencies

a. Officers of government agencies with extension programs involving literacy or continuing education;

b. Heads and members of NGOs and civil society organizations (CSOs) involved in universalizing literacy in every region;

c. Heads of LGUs, barangay chairpersons and kagawad members, barangay health workers, and other officers involved in the universalization of literacy;

d. Heads of private/corporate foundations with interest in education

or literacy; and

- e. Heads and members of academic institutions particularly those incharge of National Service Training Program-Literacy Training Service (NSTP-LTS).
- One of the highlights of the Conference is the presentation of the National Literacy Hall of Fame Award to Davao City for being three-time first place winner in the Outstanding Local Government Unit (Highly Urbanized City level) category in the National Literacy Awards. Likewise, Special Award of Excellence on Literacy will be awarded to the previous Hall of Fame awardees for sustaining their exemplary programs in literacy at least for the last three years.
- This is a live-in conference. Participants are requested to register on September 3, 2013 at any time between 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. The first meal to be served will be lunch on September 3, and the last meal to be served will be breakfast on September 6, 2013.
- A registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos only (P 5,000.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging, handouts, kits, and other workshop supplies and materials. Participants are requested to pay in cash only. For participants from DepEd, transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds of their respective offices, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. For participants from other government and nongovernment agencies, they shall make arrangements with their respective agencies for the same expenses. Enclosed is the tentative program of activities.
