The Vatican approved and elevated our community to the Diocesan Right in 1998. We have missions in India, the Philippines, Haiti, Uganda, Kenya, the United States and Indonesia. In 1993, upon the kind invitation of His Excellency, Most Rev. Leonardo Z. Legaspi, O.P., D.D., Archbishop of Caceres, we opened our first mission in the Philippines in Naga City, Bicol.
