THE FREEMAN NEWSPAPER'S LIGHT A STAR (6th EDITION) On The Spot Lantern Making Contest

OBJECTIVE:

Primarily, this is The Freeman's way of giving back at Christmas a gift to its subscriber-schools and readers; and, in doing so, encouraging pupils and students to develop their creativity and artistry, and promoting recycling practices to make them aware of the value of environmental protection.

MECHANICS:

- 1) This is an ON-THE-SPOT Lantern Making Contest, open to both public and private schools in the Visayas.
- 2) One team shall have three (3) members, all bona fide pupils/students of any grade/year level and one (1) coach (can be a teacher or adviser).
- 3) Fill up entry form, published in The Freeman starting September 23, 2013 to September 27, 2013 and shall be submitted to The Freeman Office with five (5) cutout masthead of The Freeman.
- 4) Each competing team shall bring a ready-made frame of the lantern, and shall decorate this on the contest venue (The Freeman Office); decors to be used:

Elementary: All parts of Bamboo

Qualifying size: 2ft x 2 ft

High School: All plastic container

(Plus points using URC products)

Qualifying size: 3 ft x 3 ft

- 5) Deadline for submission of Registration form is on October 4, 2013 at 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon.
- 6) On the Spot Lantern Making contest dates are as follows: Elementary - November 8, 2013 @ 8:00AM - 5:00PM (with 1 hour lunch break) High School - November 9, 2013 @ 8:00AM - 5:00PM (with 1 hour lunch break)

JUDGING PROCEDURES:

- PRE JUDGING (Selection of Top 10 to be held on November 22, 2013 (Friday)
 Pre judging or selection of the Top 10 Lanterns for each category will be based on the following percentage:
 - a. Readers' Votes
 A public voting from Nov. 11 Nov. 20, with cut-out voting forms published in The Freeman. The form is to be filled up with the choice entry and dropped at designated drop boxes.
 - b. Subscribers Bonus
 Given to entries whose school is an active subscriber of The Freeman for at least three (3) months within the contest period.
 - c. Judges' Choice 60%

A panel composed of representatives from partner institution will judge the entries according to the following:

Originality of design	30%
Artistry in use of materials	30%
Craftsmanship	20%
Relevance of design	20%

II. FINAL JUDGING (Selection of the winners) to be held on November 25, 2013 (Monday)

A new panel will judge the top 10 of each category, according to the following:

Originality of design	30%
Artistry in use of materials	30%
Craftsmanship	20%
Relevance of design	20%

ANNOUNCEMENT & AWARDING OF WINNERS:

Winners for each category shall be announced a day after the final judging and will be published in The FREEMAN. Announcement and awarding of winners will be on November 29, 2013.
