THIRD NATIONAL SECONDARY LEVEL SPECIAL EDUCATON (SPED) CONFERENCE WORKSHOP

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 202 s. 2013, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) will hold the **Third National Secondary Level Special Education (SPED) Conference Workshop** with the theme "Bridging the Gaps in School-Based Transition to Improve the Life Skills of the Students with Special Needs in the Secondary Level" on November 20-22, 2013 at the Tagaytay International Convention Center (TICC), Tagaytay City.
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a. bring together secondary level SPED practitioners and advocates from various areas in the Philippines to share their valuable experiences in providing transition programs for special students;
 - b. focus on the transition program in secondary schools to make special students self-reliant when they exit the SPED Program; and
 - c. share with the participants the Modified curriculum for Individuals with Moderate Disabilities (MCIMD) focusing on the following four areas:
 - i. daily living skills;
 - ii. personal-social skills;
 - iii. career-guidance preparation: and
 - iv. occupational skills.
- 3. The Conference Workshop will be highlighted by plenary sessions, workshops and open forums/fora.
- 4. The target participants to this activity are regular and SPED high school teachers, practitioners, school administrators, education supervisors, service providers and advocates of SPED.
