WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code provides that "Every local government unit shall xxx promote the health and safety xxx of its inhabitants";

WHEREAS, an eight (8) year old child was killed after being hit by a Public Utility Jeep while playing near a national highway in Tagunol, Barangay Pardo, Cebu City;

WHEREAS, because of the incident, there is a need to teach children/students the importance of observing proper conduct and necessary precautions along streets and other areas used as road access:

WHEREAS, this august Body finds it imperative to urge the Department of Education Region 7 in cooperation with Parents-Teachers' Associations throughout the Province of Cebu to conduct comprehensive information campaigns regarding road safety to prevent any untoward incident caused by carelessness.
