#### PROVINCIAL CHEMBLITZ GUIDELINES

#### A. THE CONTESTANTS

- 1. All participating schools must confirm their attendance with the contact persons on or before November 25, 2013.
- 2. Each school will send three (3) students currently enrolled in the third year level of high school or lower. The coach should also be employed on the same school.
- 3. Thirty (30) minutes before the competition starts, all representatives should have filled up the registration forms. A registration fee of Php 100.00 per student is required.
- 4. Students must be in their proper school uniform with their valid IDs.

#### **B. COMPETITION PROPER**

- 1. The competition consists of a written multiple choice examination.
- 2. Questions include topics from high school general chemistry, basic organic chemistry (nomenclature of hydrocarbons and functional groups to be specified), and basic biochemistry.
- 3. Calculators are allowed but have to be inspected first by the organizers before the examination begins. Pocket computers and programmable calculators are strictly prohibited.
- 4. Scratch papers are provided but should be returned at the end of the test.
- 5. Books and other reference materials are not allowed inside the examination room.
- 6. Periodic table will be provided during the competition.

#### C. ELIMINATION ROUND

1. The elimination round consists of a 60-item written examination to be taken up by each student for two (2) hours at the following locations and dates:

Registration starts at 8:00 a.m. and the examination will follow at 8:30 a.m. NO extension will be given to latecomers.

- 2. No coach is allowed inside the examination room.
- 3. Each question is worth 1 point.
- 4. Questions concerning the examination shall be addressed only to the proctor assigned in the room.
- 5. The ten highest scoring contestants will be qualified for the Regional ChemBlitz 2014 to be announced an hour after the end of the examination.
