To: Schools Division/City Superintendents
Officers-in-Charge of Regular and Interim Divisions

- 1. Enclosed is a copy of the communication from Dr. Dina S. Ocampo, Undersecretary for Programs and Projects, announcing the conduct of the Annual Conference of School Heads of Science, Technology and Engineering (STE) Implementing High Schools on November 28-30, 2013 (exclusive of travel time) in Metro Manila.
- 2. Participants to the said activity are the School Heads of the 198 STE implementing high schools (as per DepEd Order No. 28, s. 2013) and the Regional Science Education Supervisors.
- 3. Traveling and other incidental expenses of the School Heads shall be charged against the program support fund/subsidy while the costs of training including board and lodging, supplies and materials and traveling expenses of BSE staff shall be charged against the Nationwide Lump Sum in support of the ESEP Program as provided in the 2013 General Appropriations Act (Item 111.17.i). On the other hand, traveling expenses of the Regional Science Education Supervisors shall be charged against local funds. First meal shall be morning snacks on November 28 while the last meal shall be breakfast on December 1, 2013.
- 4. School Heads from **other** Science High Schools and Division Education Supervisors may participate in the aforementioned Conference, provided they shoulder the registration fee of Three Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (Php3,800.00) and their traveling and other incidental expenses, chargeable against local funds.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
