DIVISION MEMORANDUM No. 124, s. 2014

CEBU TERTIARY EDUCATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (CTEAP) FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2014-2015

To: OIC, Assistant Superintendents Education Supervisors/Coordinators Secondary School Heads

- 1. The Cebu Provincial Government, under the leadership of our Governor, Hon. Hilario Davide III, is once again reaching out to the **Top Ten** graduating high school students of this Division to apply for the **Cebu Tertiary Education Assistance Program (CTEAP) for School Year 2014-2015.**
- 2. The program requires each applicant to submit the following:
 - a. Certification from the School Head that the aspirant belongs to the **Top Ten** of the graduating students;
 - b. Certification of Good Standing from the Principal;
 - c. Barangay Clearance;
 - d. Recommendation from the Mayor and/or from the Provincial Board Member of the District where the applicant comes from; and
 - e. ITR (Income Tax Return/Tax Exemption of both parents).
- 3. Relative thereto, the applicant shall agree to take up only ladderized courses offered by State Universities and Colleges in Cebu, nearest his/her residence.
- 4. The parents of the scholar shall not have an income of over One Hundred Twenty Thousand Pesos (Php 120, 000.00) per annum, with certification from the Bureau of Internal Revenue or Municipality/City Treasurer.
- 5. Graduates from Public High Schools will be given top priority in this scholarship grant.
- 6. Successful applicants shall form a pool of scholars and will be given free tuition fee, including miscellaneous expenses and monthly allowance of Two Thousand Pesos (Php 2, 000).
- 7. The competitive examination and interview shall be announced upon passing the **pre-screening** to be handled by Mrs. Maria Elena Paras (1st Congressional District), Dr. Pamela Rodemio (2nd Congressional District), Mrs. Nenita Jaralve (3rd Congressional District), Dr. Gerardo Mantos (4th Congressional District), Dr. Mary Ann Flores (5th Congressional District) and Dr. Novie Mangubat (6th Congressional District), on **March 17 and 19, 2014** at the Promotional Section of this Office.
