

ELIGIBILITY

The conference is open to students of public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide. School officials are advised to send their students and student leaders, active members of the student council, school paper, and other school organizations. Aside from the leadership and academic qualifications, each student delegate must be of good moral character and must be physically fit to attend the workcamp and other strenuous activities. Each delegation should have a teacheradviser(s).

CONFERENCE FEE

The conference fee is FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED NINETY FIVE PESOS (P5,995.00) per delegate inclusive of meals, board and lodging, conference kit/materials, and other training expenses. Transportation expenses from point of origin to the venue and back are NOT included.

ATTIRE/ID

Delegates are required to wear casual informal attire during the Opening and Closing Geremonies. Since outdoor sports activities will be held, appropriate attire is also advised. Please bring sufficient clothes either casual, jackets sports and working. Conference ID's must be worn at all times for one's security Participants, are not allowed to enter session hall, mess hall and other workcamp activities without the ID.
