In line with the celebration of the 116th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence anchored on the theme: "KALAYAAN" Bunga ng Kagitingan, Kadakilaan at Karangalan" as announced in DepEd Memorandum No. 43, s. 2014, the department is requesting your usual support, assistance and cooperation in the following line-up activities/programs:

- Attendance of officials, teachers and students during the simultaneous Flag Raising in the following historical venues on June 12, 2014 at 7.00 o'clock a.m.
 - a. Plaza Kinse Marlirez, Naga City:

 - c. Fmilio Aguinaldo Strino, Kawit, Cavite;
 - d. Barrasoain Church Historical Landmark, Malolos, Bulacan;
 - e. Pinaglabanan Memorial Shrine. San Juan City:
 - Mausoleo de los Velaranos de la Revolución, Manila North Cemetery;
 - g. Bonifacio National Monument, Caloocan City:
 - h. Pamintuan Mansion, Angeles City, Pampanga;
 - i Davao City:

 - k. Other cities-and municipalities within the area of your jurisdiction.
- "Watawat Ko. Iwagayway Ko" (a flag in every home, office, schook, major thoroughfares, establishments, etc.) from May 26, 2014 to June 30, 2014.
- 3. The Search for the Pambarisang Gawad sa Ulirang Kabataan (PGUK) which will start June 2014 for the school, division and regional search. This search will culminate on December 2014. Mechanics of the contest will be announced later.

 Public and private elementary and secondary school heads are encouraged to conduct different classroom/campus activities related to different subject areas such as HeKaSi, Araling Panlipunan, Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga, MAPE/MAPEH, Filipino and English.

In addition, the Regional Director and Division Superintendent of the historical venues wherein simultaneous Flag Raising will be conducted are requested to represent the department during this momentous occasion. However, higher officials (Secretary, Undersecretary, Assistant Secretary) of the department will attend at the venues Plaza Kinse Martirez, Naga City and Rizal National Monument. Manila.

The travel expenses of officials and teachers and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds while the TEV of TWG, meals, uniform of exhibitors and other expenditures shall be charged to OSEC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

2014 CONDUCT OF NATIONAL OBSERVANCES AND COMMEMORATION OF HISTORICAL EVENTS

- 1. Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 23, entitled Creating a Steering Committee on National Observances, the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHP) as chair, the Department of Education (Deplet), Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), and the Department of Tourism (DOT) as members were tasked to take charge of the 2014 Conduct of National Observances and Commemoration of Historical Events, in accordance with existing laws, rules and regulations.
- 2. The activities aim to:
 - tause the level of historical/cultural awareness and consciousness of clementary pupils and secondary students relative to the significance of the national commemorations;
 - instill in their minds the greatness of the filipino race, the legacy of their national heroes, and the ideals of their nationhood; and
 - reawaken the Filipino people especially the youth of their responsibility and patriotic commitment to truly demonstrate the spirit of heroism, patriotism, nationalism, unity, and national identity.
- 3. This Memorandum will serve as a guide to all public and private schools nationwide to carry out meaningful activities integrated in related subject areas such as: Sibika at Kultura, Heograpiya, Kasaysayan, at Sining (HEKASI), Araling Panlipunan, Values Education or Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao, Music, Arts, Physical Education and Health (MAPEH), Filipino, and English during classroom discussions or school programs/events.
- 4. Enclosed is the list of national observances and historical events to be celebrated/commemorated.
- 5. Programs and activities to be conducted/undertaken during the abovementioned national observances and commemoration of historical events will be announced in a separate Memorandum.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 23

CREATING A STEERING COMMITTEE ON NATIONAL OBSERVANCES

WHEREAS, Article XIV. Section 16 of the 1987 Constitution provides that "all the country's artistic and historic wealth constitutes the cultural treasure of the nation and shall be under the protection of the State which may regulate its disposition."

WHEREAS, memories of historic events that shaped the nation constitute the soul of a people, giving meaning to their collective life and aspirations;

WHEREAS, Republic Act (R.A.) No. 10086 mandates the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) to determine all factual matters relating to official Philippine history as well as develop and implement educational materials in various media for the popularization of Philippine history;

WHEREAS, every year the NHCP initiates, through separate presidential issuances, the organization and implementation by different inter-agency committees of national observances to celebrate important events and honor key historic figures;

WHEREAS, a single directive creating a permanent planning committee will facilitate the necessary preparation and implementation, and dispense with repetitive presidential orders year to year; and

WHEREAS, the Revised Administrative Code of 1987 empowers the President of the Philippines with the continuing authority to reorganize the Executive Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BENIGNO S. AQUINO III, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order.

SECTION 1. Creation of the Committee. A Steering Committee on National Observances shall be established to plan, organize, and undertake the commemoration of selected historical events.

SECTION 2. Composition. The Committee shall be chaired by the Chairperson of the NHCP and composed of officers from the following





department or agencies with a rank not lower than Assistant Secretary, duly authorized to represent their respective Secretaries:

- a. Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG),
- b. Department of Education (DepEd); and
- Department of Tourism (DQT).

The Committee may also invite other government agencies, which it deems necessary, according to the thrust and requirements of each commemoration.

SECTION 3. Coverage. The Committee shall take charge of the following national celebrations:

- Araw ng Kagitingan;
- b Independence Day:
- c. National Heroes Day;
- d. Bonifacio Day;
- e. Rizal Day; and
- f. Other historical celebrations in accordance with existing laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 4. Power and Functions. The Committee shall have the following powers and functions:

- Formulate, organize and prescribe the manner of yearly celebrations of historical events;
- Draw up a mechanism among various national departments, local government units, and the private sector for effective mobilization and coordination of commemorative programs;
- Monitor, evaluate and submit quarterly reports to the President on all programs of the Committee; and
- d. Perform such other powers and functions as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Administrative Order.





SECTION 5. Assistance and Cooperation. All other government agencies are hereby directed to cooperate with and fully support the activities of the Committee.

SECTION 6. Funding. The Committee shall operate under the existing budget of the NHCP, except for the commemoration of the Araw no Kagitingan. which shall be charged against the funds of the Department of National Defense (DND) Any deficiency shall be charged against the regular budget of the participating agencies.

SECTION 7. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Administrative Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 8. Repealing Clause. All orders rules, regulations, and issuances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Administrative Order. are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. Effectivity. This Administrative Order shall take effect immediately.
