- Pursuant to an unnumbered DepEd Memorandum from Usec Dina S. Ocampo, Undersecretary for Programs and Projects, dated June 25, 2014, the Department of Education (DepEd), informs the field on important clarifications on Special Program in Foreign Language (SPFL)- Spanish, French Japanese, German, and Chinese Mandarin in order to address the queries on SPFL Implementation given the K to 12 developments.
- 2. Schools Division Superintendents, Division SPFL coordinators, School principals, teachers and everyone involve: in the SPFL program, are advised to adhere to the following stipulations relative to SPFL Implementation:
 - For Science High Schools:

SPFL subjects shall remain to be treated as an elective, hence, shall not carry any credit units; and can be offered as an elective in any of the following grade levels: 7 to 10, with the objective of making the students pass A1 level of proficiency for Spanish, French and German; A2+ for Japanese and Youth Chinese Test (YCT) for Chinese-Mandarin, i.e., should the student opt to take an international language proficiency exam at the end of Junior High School.

For Regular High Schools:

SPFL subjects shall remain to be part of the Career Pathways and can take the place of Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) of the core curriculum (see DepEd Order Nos. 31 and 46, s. 2012).

- Foreign Language (FL) shall be taught at a minimum of two to four hours a week to a certain class with a maximum number of 35 students.
