- 1. Per unnumbered Memorandum from Usec. Rizalino D. Rivera, Undersecretary for Regional Operations, the Department of Education (DepEd) in partnership with the Japan International Cooperation Center (JICE), spearneaded by Prime Minister Shinzo Abe, enjoin all interested students and teachers from any public high schools to join the Batch 2 of the youth exchange program between Japan and ASEAN Member States called "JENESYS 2.0" (Japan-East asia Network of exchange for Students and Youths) on November 3-11, 2014 and Batch 3 on February 9-17, 2015.
- 2. The "JENESYS 2.0" aims towards the revitalization of the Japanese economy, increasing visitors to Japan, and at the same time, promoting global understanding on Japanese values and laying a foundation for the future bond among the youths of Asian and Oceanian countries, along with mutual understanding and friendship through various activities.
- 3. In this light, this Office calls for all interested public school students to take part in the application and selection processes of this program. Students who are presently studying in any public high school for the current academic year (2014-2015) with passport, 35 to 18 years old, have a strong interest in the Japanese culture, and preferably knowledgeable in the Japanese language are highly encouraged to apply in the program. Round trip international air tickets, food and accommodation will be arranged for free by JICE.
- 4. Each Division is advised to screen (Paper Screening) interested individuals and endorse only one (1) student with his/her complete documents to the Regional Office (c/o CLMD, Attention: Mrs. Marcelita S. Dignos, Jenesys Regional Focai person) for the Regional Level Paper Screening on August 13, 2014 and for the Interview on August 14, 2014. Each region is advised to nominate a maximum of eight (8) students to the Central Office for the final paper screening on or before August 15, 2014. The Final Interview of shortlisted participants for Visayas applicants by the Central Office will be on September 3-6, 2014 at DepEd Ecotech Center. Check-in is at 6:00 PM and first meal is at 7:00 PM on September 2, 2014.
