#### Renewal Term of a Course Offered by a Private School

To: Schools Division/City Superintendents Officers-in-Charge of Regular and Interim Divisions **Education Supervisors-in-Charge of Private Schools Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors Private Schools Administrators** 

Section 43.2 of the 2010 Revised Manual of Regulations for Private Schools in Basic Education (DepED Order No. 88, s. 2010) stipulates the following provision:

A private school which has not been granted government recognition after more than five (5) renewal permits may be subject for closure.

- Section 32 of the same 2010 Revised Manual of Regulations for Private Schools (DepED Order No. 88, s. 2020) further stipulates that the Grant of Government Recognition to Private Schools shall be based on its satisfactory operation during a school year without any deficiencies in instruction, administration and/or management and in full compliance with the prescribed requirements of the course.
- Schools Divisions should provide technical assistance to any Private School that has been renewing its temporary permit to operate a complete course (preschool, elementary or secondary) for more than five (5) times already to help it qualify for the grant of government recognition. If a private school fails to meet the standards and fails to fully comply with the prescribed requirements of the course, these should be reflected in the ocular inspection report. A copy of the ocular inspection report should be given to the private school concerned and another copy should be endorsed to the Regional Director, stating a recommendation for closure of a course.
- Immediate and wide dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
