Greetings from Basa Pilipinas!

With the completion of the trainings for the school heads in facilitating Learning Action Cells (LAC) sessions last November 18-20, 2014, it is deemed important to see if acquired skills in the training were practiced and how effective are the tools provided by the project. It is also important to identify and understand the challenges faced by the school heads in facilitating their LAC sessions. With these, we are proposing a monitoring scheme for the regular checking with select school heads in their facilitation of regular LAC sessions.

The monitoring plan aims to know how the LAC sessions are being run. Specifically, it is aimed to see:

1. If the LAC sessions are being handled regularly

2. If the LAC Facilitation Guide is effective in guiding LAC facilitators

3. Challenges being faced by school heads/facilitators in facilitating LAC sessions

Monitoring will be done through school visits, interviews and witnessing LAC sessions. Five to eight schools will be regularly visited from Cebu Province Division. Four of these are handled by one School Head who may facilitate a cluster LAC session.

In this light, we hope to seek for your permission to conduct a monthly visit to the schools identified below in consultation with Dr. Flores and Dr. Rodemio, starting February to September, except for the summer months, April and May, wherein there will be no scheduled school visits for the monitoring of the LAC.
