ONE – DAY ORIENTATION OF ALL PRIVATE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS, PRINCIPALS AND ACADEMIC HEADS ON THE CLASSROOM ASSESSMENT POLICY AND THE MOTHER TONGUE CURRICULUM OF THE K TO 12 BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM

- 1. In line with the implementation of the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013 (Republic Act No. 10533) and in response to the request of the private school administrators in the province, this Office announces the conduct of a ONE DAY ORIENTATION OF ALL PRIVATE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS, PRINCIPALS AND ACADEMIC HEADS ON THE CLASSROOM ASSESSMENT POLICY AND THE MOTHER TONGUE CURRICULUM OF THE K TO 12 BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM on May 05, 2015 at the Auditorium of UCCP CenDET, 85 Osmena Boulevard, Cebu City (at the back of Bradford UCCP Church) from 8: 00 am to 5: 00 pm.
- 2. The orientation aims to orient all private school officials with the latest assessment policy of the Department and the implementation of the Mother Tongue Curriculum in the Basic Education. It will likewise hope to address some of the basic concerns and issues regarding Mother Tongue implementation and the effort to let all private school operators appreciate the importance of a congruent and coherent policy implementation of Education policy and programs under the Republic Philippines.
- 3. Participants to the orientation are the School Presidents/Administrators, Principals and Academic Coordinators who have direct supervisory authority and management of the schools. Participants shall bring along with them the current School Manual for reference during discussions and open forum.
- 4. A registration of FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P 500. 00) shall be collected by the CEDAPSA Board to defray expenses for the food, venue rental and other incidental expenses of the orientation chargeable against private school funds.

5. Wide and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired. This Memorandum serves as **Travel Authority** of the participants.
