Traveling expenses shall be chargeable against **Division MOOE** Funds, while expenses for room accommodation, meals and snacks, venue rental, training kits (honoraria of speakers/facilitators, training materials, etc.) and other incidental expenses shall be chargeable against **Division GAD** Funds, subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
