Greetings of Peace!

The U.S Peace Corps is a Volunteer Program run by the United States government and was established by Executive Order 10924 issued by President John F. Kennedy on March 1, 1961. Its stated mission is the provision of technical assistance to interested developing countries, the promotion of better understanding of American culture and the helping of Americans to understand the cultures of other countries. Since 1961, more than 8,600 volunteers have served in the Philippines in the areas of education, social work, coastal resource management and disaster response.

Together with the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), the US Peace Corps established Padayon Mindanao in 2012. This is a three-year project which supports peace building in select conflict-affected areas in Mindanao and various Peace Corps sites in the country by improving life skills of vulnerable youth through the conduct of leadership camps and literacy summits focused on promoting civic engagement and peace education. Padayon Mindanao supports Philippine Government priorities of improved literacy and peace building in Mindanao, which are still challenged by the lack of opportunities at the community level where the US Peace Corps has a well-established niche and strong partner relationship with Philippine government agencies.


For the months of <u>June to August</u>, *Pedayon Mindanao* will be holding its Literacy Summit, Youth Leadership Camp and Youth Entrepreneurship Summit in Cebu City. These events will be inviting <u>ALS teachers</u>, <u>Out-of-School Youth</u> (OSY) Leaders, and <u>Public School Youth</u> from all over Cebu and select areas in Mindanao.

The Youth Entrepreneurship Summit (YES), specifically, is a culminating event of the Youth leadership Camp inviting 800 Public school and out-of-school youth ages 15-25 years old from Cebu. It aims to promote youth entrepreneurship and business as altool for development, encouraging youth to be exposed to the benefits of entrepreneurship as a means a means for self-reliance. It invites young innovators to meet and make connections with like-minded people. The summit will feature guest speakers who have proven to be youth leaders and youth entrepreneurs to share their experiences. Attendees will have the opportunity to participate in plenary and breakout sessions which explore topics related to entrepreneurship, including but not limited to:
