- 1. Pursuant to Boy Scouts of the Philippines Cebu Council Memorandum No. 22 s. 2015, this Office announces the conduct of Basic Training Course For Kawan, Troop Leaders And Outfit Advisors For Area VI –B on October 2 -4, 2015 at Catarman Elementary School, Liloan, Cebu.
- 2. Participants to this training are the newly hired teachers who are teaching in the elementary preferably Grades 4, Grades 5 and Grades 6, teachers teaching in the secondary level, teachers in the service who want to refresh their knowledge and skills in scouting and potential leaders for boys who manifest leadership skills and interest to learn the rudiments of scouting.
- 3. A registration fee of Five Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 500.00) is asked from each participant to defray training expenses such as supplies, materials, certificates and other miscellaneous expenses.
- 4. Participants are required to wear the scout neckerchief with carabao slide. Furthermore, they are encouraged to wear casual attire and comfortable shoes. Proper decorum shall be observed all the time. Registration will start at 4:00 p.m., Friday, October 2, 2015.

- 5. Night sessions will be on Friday and Saturday. Participants are enjoined to stay in the whole duration of the training.
