DIVISION MATH EXPO 2015 CONTEST GUIDELINES

Modulo Art

Mechanics:

- 1. First placers in each category (Square Grid, Kaleidoscopic Grid, Circular Grid) in every municipality are qualified to participate.
- 2. Preliminary area elimination shall take place in the designated billeting quarters in which the participants are advised to report on or before 10:00 AM on the first day (Nov. 19, 2015).
- 3. One (1) official Modulo Art Worksheet Template will be provided to each participant bearing the participant's Entry Number.
- 4. Artworks must be finished in not more than two (2) hours in all categories.
- 5. Designs can be adjusted through stretching BUT NOT by any other methods (e.g. cropping).
- 6. Participants should bring their own colouring and drawing materials. Any colouring materials will do. Stickers are NOT allowed.
- 7. Top (3) three entries from each area shall qualify to the final judging.
- 8. The following are the criteria for judging.

c.	Neatness	<u>15%</u>
b.	Color Harmony	35%
a.	Artistry & Creativity	50%

9. Top three (3) winners during the final judging in each category will receive a medal and a Certificate of Recognition.

Math Sayaw

Mechanics:

- 1. First placers in every municipality are qualified to participate.
- 2. Preliminary area elimination shall take place in the designated billeting quarters in which the participants are advised to report on or before 10:00 AM on the first day (Nov. 19, 2015).
- 3. ONLY six (6) participants are allowed in every Dance Entry.
- 4. Performance Time shall last at least 4 minutes but must NOT exceed 5 minutes.

- 5. Dance routine may consist of various styles and lifting (limited to ONE LEVEL ONLY) EXCEPT stunts and throwing.
- 6. Participants should perform series of dance steps resembling mathematical symbols and formations which are given life through body movements utilizing their arms, legs, hands, and head. Any type of music will do (medley, remix, etc.).
- 7. There is a need to provide each judge a copy of their mathematical symbol and formations presenting their dance routine. Order of the figures must be arranged the same as how the participants performed in their routine.
- 8. There will be 12 entries to perform in the final judging on the second day (Nov. 20, 2015); of which, these consist of top three (3) dance entries coming from every area which had been determined during the pre-judging in the designated area billeting quarters.
- 9. The following are the criteria for judging.

a.	Mathematical Appeal	40%
b.	Choreography	25%
c.	Synchronization	25%
d.	Costume & Overall Impact	<u>10%</u>
	TOTAL	100%

10. Every participant of the final three (3) winning entries shall receive medals and Certificates of Recognition.
