The Teacher's Gallery (TTG) will hold its Conference on Breaking Barriers: The Inclusive Classroom with the theme An International Conference on Understanding the Challenges and Identifying the Strategies for an Effective Inclusive Education with a Global Perspective from February 19 to 21, 2016 at the Hotel Stotsenberg, Clark, Pampanga.


