FIRMING UP SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SHS) ADVOCACY AND MOBILIZATION FOR SY 2016-2017

To: All Schools Division Superintendents
Senior High School Coordinators
High School Principals

The last mile efforts on Senior High School must be done by all high schools and schools divisions before March 25, 2016. This is to strengthen information among parents and to give directions for assuring stakeholders of the readiness on Senior High School offerings.

The following maybe done:

- 1) Workshop between public and private high schools in the area to discuss the early registration results and to provide information between and among the schools offering a track the number of students coming from private that will go/enroll in their schools and vice-versa.
- 2) Inform the parents about details of "Moving On" Ceremony of Grade 10 students and the status of the schools' readiness as to number of classrooms, teachers and the submitted equipment and tools for procurement.
- 3) Recognize their donors and stakeholders who provided them support in training, technical assistance and advocacy mobilization activities on Senior High however, refrain from letting them speak in case recipient is a politician or running in any political post.
- 4) Conduct a "Career Exposition" by tapping successful alumni to speak as motivation for the Grade 10.

- 5) Meet the teachers in Grades 9 and 10 and look at the TLE specialization offering for 2016, study possible means of intensifying the Grades 9 and 10 to the Technical and Vocational track that will be offered next year. Grades 11 and 12 will be dealing on higher and complex area of that specialization rather than repeat what had been taken in Grades 9 and 10.
- 6) Campaign among the Grade 6 graduates with inclination on STEM particularly on locations with a Science High School to become the feeder of that Science High School.
- 7) Scout for more school sites to be purchased by the LGU's in highly urbanized cities so congestion will be reduced and stand alone Senior High School will be made possible on SY 2018-2020.
- 8) Other activities which the Division thinks would strengthen Senior High School Program.
- 9) Please be guided accordingly.
