- 1. This Office announces the conduct of the **DIVISION COORDINATION CONFERENCE FOR THE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SHS) ISSUES AND CONCERNS** on July 7, 2016 at Ecotech Center, Cebu City.
- 2. The conference aims to:
 - a. provide venue for the discussion and resolution of issues and concerns affecting the Senior High School (SHS) implementation;
 - b. get firsthand information from the different resource persons on the updates of the building construction, deployment of teachers, procurement of tools and equipment, partnership; and
 - c. get feedback on the curriculum implementation and programming of the SHS.
- 3. Participants to the Conference will be the Assistant Superintendents, CID and SGOD Chiefs, Education Program Supervisors/Coordinators, Division Engineers, District Supervisors, Secondary Principals and representatives of the Department of Public Work and Highways.
- 4. All secondary school heads are required to prepare and submit the following
 - June 2016 SHS Report (text, figures & pictures)
 - Enrolment Report as of Wednesday, July 6, 2016 (duly segregated)
 - Classroom Construction Updated Report (use the latest format provided) with pictures as of Thursday, June 6, 2016
- 5. A registration fee of Four Hundred Pesos (P 400. 00) will be collected to defray expenses for the venue rental, two (2) snacks, one (1) lunch and other incidental

expenses of the conference chargeable against division/school MOOE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations,
