- 2. Instructional Leadership;
- 3. Creating Student-Centered Learning Climate;
- 4. Human Resource Management and Professional Development;
- 5. Parent Involvement and Community Partnership;
- 6. School Management and Operations; and
- 7. Personal and Professional Attributes and Interpersonal Effectiveness.
