SENIOR HIGH TOP THREE DISCOUNT GRANT

(For Top 3 Students in Grade 10 from Public and Private Schools for June 2017)

I. Description:


This grant is given in recognition of the outstanding achievement or above average academic performance of students who completed the Junior High School program.

II. Admission Process and Requirements:

- 1. This discount is exclusive to Top Three students from Public and Private Schools who will be moving up to Grade 11.
- 2. Applicant must have the rank from First to Third upon completing the Junior High School.
- 3. Upon application, an applicant shall present the following to the Senior High Scholarship Coordinator:
 - 3.1. Certified True Copy of Junior High School Card (Form 138);
 - 3.2. Certified True Copy of Recommendation and Certification from the Principal that the applicant belongs to the top three (3) of the school coming from;
 - 3.3. Certificate of Good Moral Character/ Conduct issued by the school where the applicant graduated;
 - 3.4. 2pcs. 2x2 Colored Picture;
 - 3.5. Long Sized Folder; and
 - 3.6. Duly accomplished SENIOR HIGH SCHOLAR PROFILE FORM which will be given by the said office.
- 4. The applicant must fill out a Senior High Academic Scholarship Contract to be given by the Scholarship Office.

III. Benefits and Privileges:

1. The University of Cebu grants the following discounts and grants:



- 2. The applicant will pay P 500.00 as Enrolment / Registration Fee upon application. This fee shall be non-refundable should the applicant withdraw from enrolling in UC at any given period.
- 3. Discount grant is applicable to all tracks and strands.

IV. Maintaining and Sustaining the Scholarship:

- 1. To continue enjoying this scholarship, a grantee should conform/adhere to the following terms and conditions:
 - a. Maintain an average grade with a numeric equivalent of 93 with no grade below 90.
 - b. A grade below 90 in any of the subjects would mean a termination of the scholarship grant and its privileges.
- 2. The scholarship's office will update the status of the scholars every term or semester for the monitoring of the scholarship grants to be given.

V. Guidelines in Availing the Book Voucher:

- 1. A Book Voucher shall be given to the scholar through the Scholarship office in a form of a coupon which will vary according to the ranking of the scholar;
- 2. The Book Voucher can be used to purchase books at the UC Book Section only.
 The remaining amount will be paid by the grantee if the Books purchased exceed the Book Voucher amount.
- 3. The Book Voucher is non-transferable and non-convertible to Cash.
- 4. The Book voucher can only be used to purchase books prescribed by the Tracks and Strand enrolled in.
- 5. The Book voucher can only be used within its validity date.

VI. Special Provisions:

- 1. This Scholarship is non-transferrable.
- 2. A grantee is only allowed one Academic Scholarship grant per semester.
- 3. A grantee may be allowed to shift tracks or strand only once as mandated by the DepEd Memo and Order.
- 4. A grantee who wish to shift tracks or strands and wishes to transfer to another UC Campus is allowable provided it follows the mandated requirement of DepEd.
- 5. The grantee must complete the Senior High School within the prescribed period.
- 6. Should a grantee be able to finish the course beyond the prescribed time, all financial obligations for the extension shall be on the account of the student.
- 7. Summer classes or Bridging Programs as a requirement for shifting to another strand or track shall be on the account of the grantee.
- 8. Termination of Scholarship may also take effect if the grantee within the term of the grant commits a serious offense and/or infractions as defined in the students' manual; and after due process has been served and proves the errant is guilty of the charge/s.

Grades 11 & 12 SCHOLARSHIP / TOP UP DISCOUNT GUIDELINES

(Applicable SY 2017. Version November 2016.)

A. SCHOLARSHIP FOR GRADE 10 STUDENTS FROM SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL AND SPECIAL SCIENCE CLASSES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

B. GRADE 11 and 12 WORKING SCHOLARSHIP

A. SCHOLARSHIP FOR GRADE 10 STUDENTS FROM SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL AND SPECIAL SCIENCE CLASSES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

- 1. The University of Cebu grants a FULL FREE DISCOUNT per semester on the Top-up Rate only.
- 2. Grantee shall enjoy a =P= 3,000.00 voucher on Books per year (2 Semesters or Terms). The voucher can be used to purchase books at the UC Book Section only. The Book Voucher is non-transferrable and non-convertible to Cash. The Book voucher can only be used to purchase prescribed books by the Tracks and Strand enrolled in.
- 3. Upon enrolment, the grantee shall show the Certificate of Scholarship plus a Principal's Certification that grantee is of excellent academic standing from Science High School / Public School Special Science Class.
- 4. Upon enrollment, the grantee shall pay an ENROLLMENT/ADMISSION FEE OF =P= 500.00. The enrollment fee is non-refundable should an applicant decide to withdraw from enrollment.
- Scholarship is applicable to all tracks and strands.
- 6. To continue enjoying this scholarship, a grantee should conform/adhere to the following terms and conditions:
 - a. Maintain an All Passing Mark with an average of 93% and above every term or semester.
 - b. A decline in the grade average would mean a downslide on the privilege in the following semester. A downslide would mean a grantee will only avail of the Top-Up discount with reduced book allowance, such that a:

Grade Average of 90-92 = 75% Discount on Top Up/=P= 1,500.00 Book Subsidy Grade Average of 88-89 = 50 % Discount on Top Up/=P= 1,000.00 Book Subsidy

- c. No grade below 85 in all subjects. A grade below 85 would mean a termination of the scholarship grant and its privileges.
- 7. This Scholarship is non-transferrable.
- 8. A grantee is only allowed one Academic Scholarship grant per semester.
- 9. A grantee may be allowed to shift tracks or strand only once and in Grade 11 only.
- 10. The grantee must complete the Senior High School within the prescribed period.
- 11. Should a grantee be able to finish the course beyond the prescribed time, all financial obligations for the extension shall be on the account of the student.
- 12. Summer classes which are not required in the regular course shall be on the account of the student.
- 13. Termination of Scholarship may also take effect if the grantee within the term of the grant commits a serious offense and/or infractions as defined in the students manual; and after due process has been served and proves the errant guilty of the charge/s.

B. GRADE 11 and 12 WORKING SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. The University of Cebu grants a FULL FREE SCHOLARSHIP per semester on Top-Up Rate only.
- 2. Upon enrolment, the APPLICANT will have to write a letter of intent addressed to: Campus HRD, University of Cebu.
- 3. A Grantee shall enjoy a =P= 3,000.00 voucher on Books per year (good for 2 Semesters or Terms). The voucher can be used to purchase books at the UC Book Section only. The Book Voucher is non-transferrable and non-convertible to Cash. The Book voucher can only be used to purchase prescribed books by the Tracks and Strand enrolled in.
- 4. A Grantee shall also enjoy a FREE 1 set Senior High Uniform every year.
- 5. A.Grantee shall render four (4) hours of service in a particular office or station.
- 6. A Grantee shall receive Six Pesos (=P= 6.00) per hour allowance for the service rendered.
- 7. Working Scholarship is applicable to all tracks and strands.
- 8. To continue enjoying this scholarship, a grantee should conform/adhere to the following terms and conditions:
 - 8.1 Maintain an All Passing Mark with an average of 93 % and above every term or semester.
 - 8.2 No grade below 85 in all subjects. A grade below 85 would mean a termination of the scholarship grant and its privileges.
 - 8.3 Must not incur absences and/or tardiness in the work station equivalent to 12 hours per month (continuous or staggered). Absences due to invalid or unacceptable reason as assessed by the immediate superior shall be a basis for termination of the scholarship and the benefits therein.
- 9. This Scholarship is non-transferrable.
- 10. A grantee is only allowed one Academic Scholarship grant per semester.
- 11. A grantee may be allowed to shift tracks or strand only once and after Grade 11 only.
- 12. The grantee must complete the Senior High School within the prescribed period.
- 13. Should a grantee be able to finish the course beyond the prescribed time, all financial obligations for the extension shall be on the account of the student.
- 14. Summer classes which are not required in the regular course shall be on the account of the student.
- 15. Termination of Scholarship may also take effect if the grantee within the term of the grant commits a serious offense and/or infractions as defined in the students manual; and after due process has been served and proves the errant guilty of the charge/s.

SPECIAL NOTES:

- Scholars from Science High and Special Science Class will be determined by the K to 12 Help Desk by placing a mark on the Enrolment Form so that the Accounting and Cashier Section shall be informed. The Scholarship Grant Certificate will also be attached to the Enrollment Form.
- 2. Other payables to be charged to Scholars are the:
 - 2.1 I.D. with Sling and Protector (price to be determined yet)
 - 2.2 School Uniform / P.E. Uniform
- 3. The Senior High School Scholarship Program shall be handled by the Senior High School Help Desk, however, said department will give an update and give a regular report to the UC Scholarship Office.
- 4. The Senior High Principal should be the signatory in all communications and concerns about the Senior High School Scholarship program.
- 5. UC Employees with children studying in the Senior High School are not entitled to any discount/s considering that Grade 11 is a new program and the government is also providing financial assistance and subsidy.




hen was the K to 12 Program plemented?

3. What is Senior High School?

Send the School is two years of specialized upper second by Education. Students may choose a career track based on aptitude, interests, and capacity. The choice of career track will define the content of the subjects a student will take in Grades 11 and 12. These subjects fall under either the Core Curriculum and specific Career Pathways.

CORE CURRICULUM

There are eight subject areas under the Core Curriculum.
These are:

- Language
- Mathematics P.E. & Health
- Science
- Communication Social Science
- Philosophy
- Humanities

Current content from some General Education subjects are embedded in the SHS curriculum

CAREER PATHWAYS

Each student in Senior High School can choose among four tracks:

- Academic
- Technical-Vocational-Livelihood
- Arts and Design
- Sports

Additional strands offered by UC:

- Pre-Baccalaureate Maritime
- Criminology

3. Is a graduate of Senior High School employable?

Yes, a Senior High School graduate is employable and can even explore entrepreneurial options and open his/her own business, or may opt to proceed to study in College.

4. What's at stake for those who can not finish the SENIOR High School?

One can not be considered a High School graduate, thus, one can not proceed to study in College.

5. Is it possible for a student taking up Grades 7 to 10 from a public school to continue his/her SENIOR High School at UC?

Very much possible. One can proceed to be enlisted or enrolled in a preferred UC Campus.

6. What is the Voucher System?

The Senior High School Voucher Program is a way to help those who finished Grade 10 and want to continue studying in a private school. DepEd will provide a financial subsidy to all students until the end of Senior High School.

All those who finish Grade 10 from public schools are entitled to the 100% total value of the Voucher while, those who finish from a private school are entitled to 80% equivalent of the Voucher grant.

- 6. What are the advantages of taking Grade 1 at University of Cebu?
- You will graduate in Senior High School with a diploma issue by a University, thus, fortifying your credentials when you app for a job after graduation.
