- 1. There will be a Training of Trainers on Adolescent Health Education and Practical Training (ADEPT) and the Reference Material on HIV, AIDS, and STI for High School Students on May 26 27, 2017 at Crown Regency Hotel, Guadalupe, Cebu City.
- 2. This is a collaborative effort of the Department of Education (DepEd), Department of Health (DOH), and Cebu Plus Association Incorporated (CPAI) to address epidemic issues among adolescents.
- 3. Participants to this training are the Schools Division MAPEH Supervisors/Coordinators and Identified MAPEH Teachers who will conduct an echo-training seminar in their respective Schools Division (see attached list of participants).
