2ND PROVINCIAL BIODIVERSITY WILDLIFE POSTER MAKING CONTEST AND **6TH CEBU PROVINCIAL WILDLIFE QUIZ**

This Office announces that the Cebu Technological University (CTU) -Argao Campus 1. together with the Philippine Biodiversity Conservation Foundation, Inc. (PBCF) and the Cebu Provincial Government will hold the 2nd Wildlife Poster Making Contest for the elementary level and the 6th Cebu Provincial Wildlife Quiz for the secondary level. The theme for the Elementary Poster Making Contest is "Connecting People to Nature," increases awareness among school children on the value of Philippine Biodiversity through art expression. The medium is only watercolor and cartolina. The organizers will provide the cartolina while contestant will bring his/her own watercolor.

The contest will have three (3) cluster competitions as follows:

On the other hand, northern Cebu comprises Carmen, Catmon, Sogod, Borbon, Tabogon, Bogo City, Medellin, Daanbantayan, san Remigio, Tabuelan, Tuburan, Asturias, Balamban, Bantayan Island and Camotes Islands. Lastly, southern

Cebu is composed of Carcar, Sibonga, Argao, Dalaguete, Alcoy, Boljoon, Oslob, Santander, Samboan, Ginatilan, Malabuyoc, Alegria, Badian, Moalboal, Alcantara, Ronda and Dumanjug.

Each contestant will only be given two (2) hours and thirty (30) minutes to finish his/her entry. Criteria for judging will be announced before the start of the contest. Top ten (10) entries will be selected from each cluster as finalists. The thirty (30) final entries will be exhibited and judged on August 2, 2017 during the 6th Provincial Wildlife Quiz at the Capitol Social Hall. Top three (3) winners will be awarded after the Quiz and Certificates be given to all participants and their respective coaches. Medals will be given to finalists and cash prize plus trophies to the winners.

- 2. The 6th Cebu Provincial Wildlife Quiz will be conducted on August 2, 2017 (1:00 PM) at the Capitol Social Hall, Cebu City. This annual Quiz is conducted in order to raise awareness on the conservation importance of the country's endemic and threatened wildlife. The topics shall cover general information in Science, biodiversity, endemic & threatened species, environmental laws, environmental news and discoveries related to biodiversity.
- 3. Each participating school shall form a team of two (2) students (Junior or Senior High School) and a coach. Trophies and cash prizes will be given to the winners. Certificates and other information materials will also be distributed to the participants during the event. The top three (3) winners of the Quiz will be representing Cebu in the 3rd National Wildlife Quiz in November together with other provincial winners.
