- The Department of Health in partnership with Redscope Communications, Inc. and in coordination with this Office is expanding the SuperKID Linis Lusog School Caravan for SY 2017-2018. The campaign aims to increase awareness among the school populace on developing the habit of handwashing as a basic health / hygienic practice that can prevent infectious diseases and as embodied in the policy and guidelines of the Comprehensive Water, Sanitation and Hygiene in Schools Program per DepED Order No. 10, s. 2016.
- The SuperKID Linis Lusog School Caravan is composed of two (2) activities: 2.
- a)Continuing Health Education for Teachers (CHET), an annual assembly that aims to provide updates and new trends relevant to school health. This year's theme is "Health comes first" which focus on the importance of handwashing as a single most effective practice to prevent diseases.
- b) The SuperKID Linis Lusog School Caravan which will be conducted in identified schools of the thirteen (13) Schools Divisions consist of two (2) events: 1) Handwashing Video Shows, Relay, Quiz Bee and Champion Oath Taking for Grades 1-3 learners and 2) Health 101 Lectures for Mothers. Both will be implemented in one (1) day per school only for a maximum of 60-minutes duration per event.
- A project launching will be conducted at 1:00 P.M. on August 25, 2017 at Waterfront Hotel, Lahug, Cebu City. Participants to the launching shall be the Schools Division Superintendents (SDS) and Asst. Schools Division Superintendents (ASDS), SGOD Chief, Health Personnel (at least 3 per SDO), PSDS, and School Head and First Aid Teacher of the identified 476 schools within the region. Attached is the required number of elementary schools per Schools Division. The list of schools shall be submitted on or before August 16, 2017 to ESSD Office, DepED Region VII.

Redscope personnel will be coordinating with the Schools Division Office regarding the schedule of this dry run activity. Likewise, the Redscope teams will also coordinate with the School Head of the identified schools to secure the schedule of the event.
