To further help our learners with visual impairment in SPED program through our Primary Eye Care 2 Project, "Ensuring the Continuum of Care", our Cebu office in partnership with USAID would like to conduct the following activities on the month of September and October 2017 in some selected schools within your Division:

- Two-Day Orientation for Receiving Teachers, Provincial, Municipal/City and Barangay Health officers, Provincial and Municipal Social workers, school nurses and Parents, of Children with Visual Impairment among other stakeholders;
