- 2. Activities during the NSCM Celebration Seminar/Workshop includes plenary sessions, group dynamics, interactive workshop, round table discussion, poster sessions, practicum, and assessment geared toward the achievement of objectives.
- 3. The Regional Directors, School Division Superintendents and School Heads are encourage to send their participants to the Seminar/Workshop. The Regional Science Supervisor in charge of the Programs and Projects shall undertake the coordination in the field offices pertinent to their participation in the seminar.
- 4. Science Club Adviser from each Division is required to submit a Narrative Report of their 2017 Science Club Month Celebration with Supporting Documents for the Assessment of the Programs and Project they have Conducted in their division.
- 5. A Registration Fee of Four thousand five hundred (P4500) shall be charged each participant for Board and Lodging from Dinner of Day 1 September 27 to pm Snacks of Day 4 September 30. Registration, transportation expenses and other incidental expenses may be chargeable against school funds, local funds, school board funds, NGO's and Non-DEPED resources subject to availability of funds, usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.
