

The University of the Philippines (UP) Office of Admissions is currently preparing for the UP College Admission Test (UPCAT) 2018 which will be administered on October 21 and 22, 2017 in 76 Test Centers nationwide. This is the first regular UPCAT after the full implementation of the K to 12 program and over 80,000 applicants are expected to take the said admission exam this year.

The University looks forward to having more applicants and more qualifiers from public schools for UPCAT 2018. In line with this, the UP Office of Admissions will be conducting **roadshows** to different public schools in the country to orient prospective Senior High School (SHS) graduates about the University of the Philippines and the UPCAT. Assistance is also requested in identifying divisions/schools where they can maximize the conduct of the roadshow.

The deadline for submission of UPCAT 2018 applications for students from public schools in Metro Manila is August 25, 2017 while the deadline for students from the provinces is September 1, 2017.

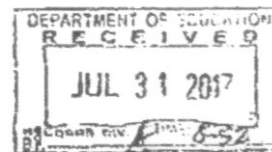
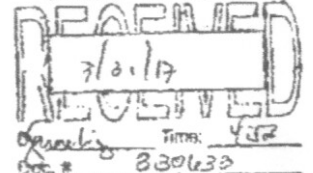

Greetings!

The UP Office of Admissions is currently preparing for UPCAT 2018 which will be administered on October 21 & 22, 2017 in 76 Test Centers nationwide. This is the first regular UPCAT after the full implementation of the K-12 program in the country and we expect over 80,000 applicants this year (there were 88,554 applicants for UPCAT 2015).

Because of the "gap years" brought about by the change in the Secondary Education curriculum, there have been very few UPCAT applicants from public high schools (graduates from earlier years, special cases) in the last 2 years. The University looks forward to having more applicants, and hopefully more qualifiers, from the public schools for UPCAT 2018, thereby ensuring that the UP will continue to have the extensive diversity that is essential for the community and all its individual members to flourish.

In line with this, we would like to ask your Office for assistance as we go on a roadshow to different public schools in the country so that we may tell prospective Senior High School graduates about the University of the Philippines and the UPCAT. We have already given the same talk to various private schools who have invited us for their respective college orientation programs. Thus, we want to reach out to the public schools to make sure that the same information, and whatever advantage such knowledge may provide, can be made available to their students. Specifically, we ask for your help in identifying which schools/districts we can give the talk to for maximum effect, as well as your endorsement to the proper authorities so that we may be given the time and venue to give the UPCAT Orientation to Grade 12 and Grade 11 students in their schools.

The posted deadline for submission of UPCAT 2018 applications for students from public schools in Metro Manila is August 25, 2017 while the submission deadline for students from the provinces is September 1, 2017. We would therefore greatly appreciate any assistance you can provide so that we may be able to schedule and send our representatives to at least 4 public schools: 1 in Luzon (non-MM), 1 in the Visayas, 1 in Mindanao and 1 in Metro Manila by the first week of August.

We look forward to working with the Department of Education in this project and in similar endeavours aimed towards increased opportunities for development of the Filipino youth and progress of our country.

WHO MAY TAKE THE UPCAT

1. Senior high school students expecting to graduate in 2018 from a DepEd-accredited high school or an accredited secondary school abroad; OR
2. Graduates of a DepEd-accredited high school or accredited secondary school abroad; OR
3. PEPT (Certified Eligible for college); AND
4. With final grades for three (3) high school years preceding the year of graduation; AND
5. Must not have taken any college subject's prior to taking the UPCAT; AND
6. Must not have taken the UPCAT previously.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Correctly and completely accomplished UPCAT APPLICATION FOR FRESHMAN ADMISSION (UPCAT Form 1), SECONDARY SCHOOL RECORD (UPCAT Form 2) and other relevant attachments (e.g. P137, CMU, Certification, DepEd Certification, PEPT).
2. Four 2"x2" identical recent photographs.
3. Validated deposit slip as proof of payment of Application Fee, or documents for exemption from payment.
4. The non-refundable UPCAT Application Fee is:
 - (1) P450 for Filipinos with annual gross family income of more than P130,000 and resident foreign applicants studying in the Philippines; OR
 - (2) US\$550 for non-resident foreign applicants; OR
 - (3) US\$100 for applicants taking the UPCAT in the Middle East.

- a. Exempted from payment of the application fee are Filipino applicants belonging to either of the groups:
 - (1) Those with annual gross family income of P130,000 or less (submit 2016 ITRs of earning members of the family or BIR Certification of Exemption); OR
 - (2) Top ten graduates of prospective graduates of public high schools the SY 2016-2017 (submit a ranked overall list of the school's TOP TEN students across all curriculum programs and be accompanied by SY 2016-2017 signed by the School Head/Principal).

25 August 2017 - Metro Manila Public Schools
1 September 2017 - Non-Metro Manila Schools
