GENERAL GUIDELINES

PSM-VISAYAS REGIONAL STUDENT RESEARCH COMPETITION 2017

I. Levels and Categories of Research Entries

Research project should be in any area of microbiology. Entries submitted should indicate whether it is for oral or poster presentation. No entry can be considered for both categories.

A. Oral Presentation

Level 1 Secondary Level

Level 2 Undergraduate Level .

Level 3 Graduate Level

A group leader should be appointed for each team who will be the coordinator and spokesperson for the group. However, each member should be fully involved and familiar with all aspects of the project.

All names of group members must be included on the abstract. Only the group leader shall be allowed to present and act as spokesperson to defend the project during the day of presentation. However, other members of the group should also be present for any inquiries regarding the project.

B. Poster Paper

II. Qualifications

1. Level 1: Secondary Level

Open to all students in public and private schools in Visayas Region for school year 2017-2018. High School students should not be more than 21 years old. Schools may send more than one entry.

2. Level 2: Tertiary Level

Open to all students enrolled in BS Biology, BS Medical Technology, BS Public Hygiene, BS Pharmacy, BS Nursing, BSEd (Biology or General Science), Life Sciences or related fields in all tertiary schools in Visayas Region for Academic Year 2017-2018. Schools may send more than one entry.
