An On-The-Spot Lantern Making Contest

OBJECTIVE:

Light A Star is a yearly project of The Freeman Newspaper's to encourage students to develop their creativity and artistry, as well as promote recycling practices and use of indigenous materials to make them aware of the importance of protecting the environment.

MECHANICS:

- > This is an On-The-Spot Lantern Making Contest, open to both public and private schools in the Visayas.
- > One team shall have three (3) members who are all bona fide students of any grade/year level and one (1) coach (can be a teacher or adviser)
- Fill up entry form and submit to The Freeman Newspaper office with three (3) cut-out masthead of The Freeman Newspaper.
- Contest time is four (4) hours. A penalty of .25 points will be deducted from the overall score for every minute excess during the pre-judging.
- ➤ Each competing team shall bring a ready-made frame of the lantern and shall decorate this at the venue (SM City Cebu Activity Center); decors to be used:

Elementary:

Used Plastic Spoons

- Qualifying Size: 2 ft. x 2 ft. inclusive of rings and other accessories, but excluding the tail
- High School:

Plastic bottles caps

- Qualifying Size: 2 ft. x 2 ft. inclusive of rings and other accessories, but excluding the tail
- ➤ Deadline for submission of registration forms will be on October 16, 2017 (Monday) 5 o'clock in the afternoon at the Freeman Newspaper office located at D. Jakosalem cor. V. Gullas Sts., Barangay Sto. Nino, Cebu City or email to joseph_dematera@yahoo.com
- > All entries must be lighted and a nativity will be included in the design of lantern.
- ➤ Deduction of ten (10) points for every violations of contest rules / mechanics, and applied during the pre-judging.

- > An automatic disqualification is implemented if violation exceed to two (2) or 20% deductions.
- On-The-Spot Lantern making contest dates are as follows;
 - Elementary November 09, 2017 @ SM City Cebu Activity Center
 - High School November 10, 2017 @ SM City Cebu Activity Center
- ➤ All entries is to be exhibit / display at SM City Cebu from November 09, 2017 to November 28, 2017
- Final Judging and Awarding Ceremonies is on November 29, 2017 @ 2 o'clock in the afternoon at the Activity Center of SM City Cebu.

JUDGING PROCEDURES:

> Pre-Judging (Selection of Top 10 to be held on November 9 & 10, 2017 during on the spot contest in SM City Cebu)

Pre-Judging or selection of the Top 10 finalist for each category will be based on the following:

Reader's Vote 15%

A public voting from Nov. 18 to 25, 2017, with cut-out voting forms published in The Freeman Newspaper. The form is to be filled up. With the choice entry and dropped at designated drop boxes.

• Subscribers Bonus 15%

Given to entries whose school is an active subscriber of The Freeman for at least three (3) months within the contest period.

• Panel of Judge 15%

A panel composed of representatives from partner's institution will judge the entries according to the following criteria:

- Originality of design 30%
 Show the new and unique design which is relevant to the objectives of the contest
- Artistry in use of materials 40%
 90% usage of main materials, skills in transforming these into a work of art.

Craftsmanship 20%
 Clean rendition of materials and skillful work for a sturdy product

Overall Impact
 Over all visual attraction, it's compatibility with the lights used

Final-Judging (Selection of winners to be held on November 29, 2017 – Wednesday 11:00 AM at SM City Cebu. A new panel of judges will select the winners for each category according to the following criteria:

Originality of design	30%
Artistry in use of materials	40%
Craftsmanship	20%
Overall Impact	10%

- > Announcement of ten (10) finalist will be on November 24, 2017 Friday
- > Announcement of winners / awarding ceremonies and raffle draw is on November 29, 2017 Wednesday, 2:00 PM at SM City Cebu.
