



Greetings from the Department of Information and Communications Technology [DICT)!

It is the DICT's mandate to ensure the rights of individuals to privacy and confidentiality of their personal information; ensure the security of critical ICT infrastructure including information assets of the government, individuals, and businesses; and provide oversight over agencies governing and regulating the ICT sector and ensure consumer protection and welfare, data privacy and security, foster competition, and the growth of the ICT sector.

To fulfill this mandate, National Cybersecurity Plan (NCSP) 2022 was launched last December 9, 2016 and followed by a Roundtable Discussion with different NGA's, Academe and Private Sectors last January 23, 2017. It aims to address the urgency to protect the nation's Critical Infostructure; Government Networks both Public and Military; Small Medium Enterprises to Large Businesses, Corporations, and its supply chains; and every Filipino using the internet.

Under the 4th Key Imperative of the NCSP, we have identified the integration of Cybersecurity in the education system as a vital tool in creating awareness, thus protecting each individual.

To fulfill this mandate, we are holding a CyberSecurity Awareness Caravan that aims to raise awareness on the importance of Cybersecurity and to help educate, empower, and protect the individuals in cyberspace. The seventh leg of our Caravan is on December 18, 2017, 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM at the Gymnasium of University of San Carlos, Cebu City. This caravan is the Cybersecurity Awareness Campaign of DICT that will be held in different regions of the Philippines.
