MARIAN FESTIVAL AND CONTEST 2018

Theme: "Santo Rosaryo, Pagninilay sa Buhay ni Hesus, lakas ng naglilingkod sa Panginoon."

CONTEST GUIDELINES

- The contests are open only to all the members of MHCC from Public and Private High Schools of the different divisions. Any other students who are not a member are not allowed to join.
- 2. All participants must be properly endorsed by their animators or school principals through a formal letter addressed to the MHCC.

CONTEST MECHANICS

1. Bulletin Design Contest

- a. The size of the bulletin board must not be less than 3ft x 5ft.
- All materials used in the bulletin board must be made from 100% recycled materials with the exemption of cohesive materials.
- c. The Bulletin Board must reflect the nature of true Marian Crusader as it expounds the Catholic Faith and can be a material of Catechism to the School.
- d. The Bulletin Board must be finished on or before October 20.
- e. The Judges will start visiting the participating school from October 15 until October 19.
- f. Each Bulletin Board shall be evaluated according to:

Originality 20%
Artistic Interpretation 30%
Relevance to the Theme 30%
Catholic in Nature 20%

- g. The Judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
- h. Organizers reserve the right to nullify and/ or cancel any part of the competition if it appears that any fraud or malfunctions have occurred in any form or whatsoever.

2. On the Spot Poster Making Contest

- a. Posters are to be completed within 2 hours at the Marian Festival venue on the date of the activity.
- b. The participants are to use oil pastel or crayon pass, 3 colors only blue, red and yellow, as their medium and are limited to use of % illustration board. Participants shall provide their own materials.
- c. All entries must be new and original.
- d. For the purpose of anonymity, the artist's real name, school, and/or other contact details must only appear on the official registration form and in the manifesto, which shall be signed before the start of the contest proper.
- The number which corresponds to the name in the manifesto shall be written on the top portion of the paper provided for the Poster Making Contest.

h. Organizers reserve the right to nullify and/ or cancel any part of the competition if it appears that any fraud or malfunctions have occurred in any form or whatsoever.

3. On the Spot Slogan Making Contest

a. Slogans are to be completed within 1hour.

- b. Each individual shall bring his/her own % cartolina, pentel pen and a set of oil pastels.
- c. A slogan, which shall serve as the title of the artwork, must be in Filipino and will not exceed 12 words.
- d. For the purpose of anonymity, the artist's real name, school, and/or other contact details must only appear on the official registration form and in the manifesto, which shall be signed before the start of the contest proper.
- e. The number which corresponds to the name in the manifesto shall be written on the top portion of the paper provided for the Poster Making Contest.
- f. The use of mobile phones and/or other electronic devices is prohibited during the contest proper.
- Each artwork shall be evaluated according to:

Clarity of the Message	35%
Creativity	25%

h. The Spot Simultaneous judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

Marian Song Competition and Singing Contest

- a. The song must be submitted to the designated brother o sister for the contest before your actual performance.
- b. Songs shall be written in Filipino, typewritten on a short bond paper (3 copies).
- Guitar is the only accompaniment allowed in the competition.
- d. 2 singers and 1 guitarist are allowed to song perform the (live) on October 20
- e. Each song shall be evaluated according to:

- b. It should be in Filipino and in connection with the theme.
- c. Each speech shall be evaluated according to:

8. Marian Quiz Bee

- a. Only one MHCC boy and one MHCC girl from each school are required to join the quiz.
- b. All the questions will be derived from the Mary, look a-like Contest. The participants will be given enough time to study and reflect the different Titles.
- c. Participants must bring with them ball pen and papers.
- d. The questions will only be repeated twice.
- e. The greatest number of correct scores will be declared winners.

9. Mary, Look-a-Like Contest

- a. There will only be one title of the Blessed Virgin Mary in every school that will be imitated and it will be assigned by the organizer.
- b. The image and the story of the assigned title of the Blessed Virgin Mary must be known to the bearer, printed and posted nicely near the contestant so that others can gain knowledge about it.

- L For all of us gathered here: May they continue to follow what our Lady of Fatima asked us to do, namely conversion, offering and reparation. We pray.
- L For ourselves that, like Mary, we may become ever more close followers of Crist. We pray.
- L Let us pray for our other intentions. (Pause)
- P O God, we humbly pray that with Mary, the Mother of your Son, pleading for us, you grant all that is for our god. This we ask you through the same Crist our Lord.

FAREWELL PRAYER

Mother Mary, you are not only our Mother but also the queen of our hearts. We give ourselves entirely to you as a proof of our devotion; we consecrate our whole lives to you. Since loving Mother we are your own, guard us and protect us from every evil that could harm us. Give us your special protection and we will no longer worry about life's trials and distress. May our soul desire be to please your son, our Lord Jesus Christ, by following His most Holy Will.
