

Greetings of Joy and Peace!

It is our pleasure to inform you that the Annual Teachers' Congress of the Catholic Educational Association of the Philippines- Cebu Secondary Schools Principals' Association (CEAP-CeSSPA) in the Cebu Province is scheduled on November 16, 2018 at the International Convention Center of Cebu (IC3).

The Teachers' Congress, which is an annual gathering of teachers from more than fifty secondary schools of CEAP Region VII aims to forge collaboration among schools, provide a venue for interaction of the teachers, and keep them abreast of the priorities in Catholic education, and the current trends in education, in general. Specifically for this year, it is also the goal of the Teachers' Congress to strengthen and empower the Subject Area Groupings of CEAP-CeSSPA.

The Teachers' Congress, to be attended by approximately one thousand four hundred (1,400) participants shall carry the theme of the CEAP National Convention, "SANCTIFICATIO: from Brokenness to Blessedness". It shall start with the Registration at 7:30 in the morning and shall be formally opened with the blessing of the Eucharistic Celebration at 8:00 in the morning to be officiated by Rev. Fr. Dionisio Miranda, SVD, the CEAP Region VII Trustee.

The keynote speech of Fr. Joel Tabora, SJ, the CEAP National President on "Brokenness to Blessedness: A Call for Transformation as Professional Teachers" shall highlight the morning.

The afternoon shall proceed with the concurrent sessions of the different subject areas with a workshop and a Business Meeting. The Sinag ng Karunungan Service Award and the Closing ceremonies shall cap the CeSSPA Teachers' Congress 2018.

It is in this regard, that this letter is sent, on behalf of CeSSPA, to formally request permission from your office to consider this day of the Teachers' Congress as a school day for its member schools as part of the Teachers' Professional Development.
