## 2019 METROBANK-MTAP-DEPED MATH CHALLENGE ELIMINATION ROUND AND AREA LEVEL MATH EXPO (Elementary)

1. This office announces the conduct of **2019 Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge Elimination Round and Area Level Math Expo** for public and private elementary schools on January 17, 2019 on the following venues;

- 2. Participants to the Math Challenge Elimination Round are the district winners from the public schools and the school winners from those private schools who have registered online on the Metrobank Math Challenge portal.
- 3. Each district is expected to have contestants on the following during the area level:
  - a. Math Challenge for Grades 1-6 with 3 participants per grade level;
  - b. Math Art;
  - c. Math Sayaw;
  - d. Math Jingle;
  - e. Damath (Levels 1-3); and
  - f. Mathematician look-alike
- 4. The theme for the competition is "Math for Life: Creating Problem Solvers and Critical Thinkers" and its overall objective is to contribute in improving the quality of Mathematics education. Specifically, it aims to:
  - a. Awaken greater interest in Mathematics among diversified learners in both public and private schools in the division;
  - b. Challenge learners to hone their multiple intelligences and strive for mathematical excellence;
  - c. Empower mathematical talents with awards and recognitions for them to serve as models to the youth, and;
  - d. **S**trengthen teamwork and collaboration among teachers and parents in developing critical thinker and problem-solver learners.

- 5. Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of this activity such as meals and snacks of the participants, and other expenses relative thereto, shall be chargeable to **Division MTAP funds**, while traveling expenses of the participants, coaches, officiating officials, school heads and district supervisors who will attend the activity shall be chargeable to **local School MOOE/SEF/PTA Funds**, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. This Memorandum serves as participants' Authority to Travel.
