Warm greetings from Smart Communications!

We are happy to inform you that we have already completed last year the training and distribution of the Smart School-in-a-Bag (SIAB) packages to DepEd Cebu Province's 18 public elementary schools in partnership with the Rotary Club of Cebu.

On March 13 and 14 (8am-5pm), we will have the SIAB Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) workshop at the G/F Multipurpose Hall, Smart Regional Office, Pope John Paul II Avenue, Mabolo, Cebu City. The M&E workshop will be conducted by our partners from the Philippine Normal University.

Thus, we would like to invite the principal/school head and their ICT teachers, who attended the SIAB Training last year at Alicia Hotel, Banilad, Cebu City. We are expecting two (2) representatives per school to attend. Please see attached for the list of schools for your reference.

For the workshop, Smart will handle the following:

- -workshop participants' (principals/school heads and ICT teachers) meals and snacks

As a pre-requirement to the Smart School-in-a-Bag Monitoring & Evaluation workshop, we would like to request the principals/school heads or whoever she will assign to administer the giving and collecting the pre-workshop survey questionnaires (attached) to the principal, teachers, students, and other stakeholders of School-in-a-Bag in your school/community and to bring the accomplished survey forms during the training. The results of the survey will then be shared and talked about during the workshop.



Per school is also required to create a Brief Presentation or Status Report on how they are using the SIAB in their respective communities which they will present on March 14. Here are guide questions for their presentations:

- 1. Provide a brief description on the context of your area/school/community (use photos/videos)
  - 2. When did the Smart School-in-a-Bag Program start in your area/school/community?
- 3. How do you implement the program (i.e., use of the School-in-a-Bag, application of skills learned through training, etc.)
- 4. So far, how is it helping you and your students? You are REQUIRED to show evidence like sample work from you students, record of students' performance, etc.
- 5. What issues have you and your students encountered in the program? How did you resolve these issues?
- 6. Is there anything else you would like to share on the status of the program in your area/school/community?

We hope to have a complete attendance from all the 18 recipient-schools.
