The Ramon Aboitiz Foundation, Inc. (RAFI) through the Biodiversity Conservation Unit have conducted a program orientation with the DEPED District NGP Coordinators in Northern Cebu's 4th and 5th Congressional District regarding the AEV-DEPED-RAFI Tree Growing Program last January 23, 2019. At present, only sixty-three (63) schools have signified their interest and have submitted their Letter of Intents (LOIs) to be part of the 2nd batch of the said program. The minimal turn-out of possible school partners is maybe due to the lack or limited understanding of the program at the local school levels as we need one hundred forty-eight (148) schools for Batch #2. As discussed with Dr. Eva Casinillo, there is a need to conduct a re-orientation to all local School NGP Coordinators at the district level for more program understanding and support.

In this regard, we are requesting for a meeting with all the School District Supervisors, School Principals, School and District NGP In-charge or Coordinators for a program re-orientation of the school-based tree growing project. Please refer to the table below for the orientation schedules.
