DEVELOPMENT OF CONTEXTUALIZED CURRICULUM INTEGRATION MODEL

- 1. Pursuant to Republic Act 10533 entitled "Enhanced K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum" and in compliance with DepED Order No. 42, s. 2019 re Adoption of Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST), and DepED Order No. 8, s. 2015 on "Policy Guidelines on Classroom Assessment for the K to 12 Basic Education Program", this Division has developed a contextualized curriculum integration model dubbed as *Integrated Curriculum for Cebuano learners to Engage for Better Understanding* (I C CEBU).
- 2. I C CEBU Model is an approach to respond to the learning needs of Cebuano learners, which places an emphasis on advance content knowledge, relies on higher order thinking skills, and focuses on developing the learners' competencies within and across several disciplines.
- 3. To ensure its effective implementation, this Division has scheduled a series of activities to be held at Ecotech Center, Lahug, Cebu City on the dates specified below:

 - 4.3 demonstrate strong commitment in implementing I C CEBU Model.
