The Tech4ED Program would like to tap different kinds of stakeholders coming from various sectors of the society. This includes LGUs, NGOs, and other private partners.

## Where can Tech4ED centers be established?

**A**

Ideally, Tech4ED centers should be where target customers can flock. Specifically in LGUs, FITS centers, public libraries, schools, cooperatives, barangay halls, associations of PWDs and/or senior citizen centers, among others.

## How does one establish a Tech4ED center?

**A**

The Tech4ED centers' material requirements are, but not limited to:

- Office space – not smaller than 20sqm
- WiFi connectivity and router – at least 1 router
- Three (3) computers
- Three (3) computer tables with chair
- Three (3) tables and chairs (for users who will bring their own laptop)
- One (1) personnel
- SB resolution (Sangguniang Bayan)
- To follow the operating hours:  
M-F (1-9PM); Sat (9AM-5PM); Sun (12-5PM)
