MASS TRAINING ON RONDALLA FOR MUSIC TEACHERS

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- This Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division will conduct the Mass Training on Rondalla for Music Teachers on May 15-19, 2019 at DepEd Ecotech Center, Sudlon, Lahug, Cebu City.
- 2. The program outcomes for the training include the following:
 - demonstrate musical and pedagogical knowledge and skills in solo/group rehearsal, performance, and in general music classroom experiences through rondalla music;
 - b. show appreciation to varied music genre as well as diverse forms of music culture in the Philippines through rondalla music; and
 - promote and preserve Filipino rondalla music through public performances and cultural shows.
- 3. The participants of the said training are the Division MAPEH Supervisors and the mapped teachers with skills in playing rondalla instrument. They are expected to bring the following:
 - a. rondalla instrument (Banduria, Laud, Octavina, Guitar, Bajo de Arco);
 - b. music stand;
 - c. long black clear book;
 - d. pick (plectrum);
 - e. extra strings (#0, 1, 2, 3)
 - f. beige Barong Tagalog for male and beige Filipiniana dress for female;
 - g. digital chromatic tuner (can be downloaded from playstore);
 - h. music writing notebook, pencil, eraser;
 - i. band aids; and
 - j. 1 round rag.
- 4. Traveling and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants are chargeable against school MOOE/local funds while board and lodging will be charged to HRTD Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. The participants shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with the provisions of DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2011, and DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003. Likewise, non-teaching personnel including management staff shall be provided with Compensatory-Time-Off (CTO) on training days which fall on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays per CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004.
