- 1. For the information and guidance of all concerned, attached herewith is the Council Memorandum No. 22, Series 2019 which entitled "Basic Training Course for Kawan and Troop Leaders".
- 2. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Cebu Council Area X-2 (Dalaguete I, Dalaguete II, Alcoy, Boljoon, Oslob and Santander) announces the conduct of Live-in Basic Training Course for Kawan Leaders (BTC KL) and Troop Leaders (BTC TL) at Oslob Central Elementary School, Oslob, Cebu on July 5-7, 2019.
- 3. We are inviting teachers for Basic Training Course for Kawan and Troop Leaders; teachers who are handling KAB Scouts (Grades 1-3) and Boy Scouts (Grades 4-6) to attend this Basic Training Course. Participants to this training must be currently registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines Cebu Council.
- 4. Registration Fee: A registration fee of FIVE HUNDRED PESOS ONLY (Php500.00) shall be charged to each participant to defray the cost of meals for the staff, transportation, materials/supplies and other administrative expenses.
- 5. Participants are encouraged to wear their Scout neckerchief. Furthermore, they should come in casual attire and comfortable shoes. Appropriate attire should be observed all the time. The opening ceremonies will start at 5:00pm on Friday, July 5, 2019. Closing ceremonies will be on Sunday, Afternoon, July 7, 2019.

- 6. Night sessions are conducted on Friday and Saturday. Participants are strictly to stay within the venue until the whole duration of the training so that the sessions with office landline number (032) (261-1402) or (418-6258).
- 7. Relative to the conduct of the Basic Training Course for Kawan and Troop Leaders held on July 5-7, 2019, hereunder details the additional provision to wit:
 - 7.1. Service Credits will be granted to participating teachers on the number of actual attendance of teachers during the program subject to the guidelines set stipulated in DepEd Order 53, s. 2003, "Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers". Claims of Service Credits shall be by district but arranged by school for both elementary and secondary levels.
 - 7.2. For the School Heads they will be given Compensatory Time-off (CTO) for the services they rendered on July 6-7, 2019 (Saturday and Sunday respectively) in accordance to the existing Civil Service Commission (CSC) or DepEd Orders Issuances.
