
SYNOPSIS



















Listed below are some of the highlights the film aims to promote:

- PROMOTION OF MOTHER TONGUE the film is incorporated with "tula" as part of the delivered dialogues. Said dialogues include a number of original poems written by the filmmaker. To sum up, the film promotes not only our mother tongue, but also the use and appreciation of Filipino poems through film.
- ANTI-BULLYING a scene in the film is dedicated to show that any form of bullying is not tolerated in school, and bullying does not go unpunished. The film also aims to show the bullies how their parents worry about them and their future.





- 3. **JUAN TAMAD STORY RETOLD** as part of the tribute to the iconic character, Fabio tells his grandchildren the famous story of Juan Tamad using shadow puppetry.
- 4. SHADOW PUPPETRY believed to be the oldest form of storytelling presentation (or one of the oldest), the film exhibits shadow puppetry to show how children used to enjoy stories told by the elders. 

In an era when local film fare consists of gritty indie fare, romantic comedies, and Hollywood imports, wholesome, family-oriented entertainment will always have a place reserved for it, especially when the movie stars popular and talented child actors.

Go over local film history and it will be revealed that the industry has seen through the decades how modestly-budgeted movies like "Mga Basang Sisiw" and "Mga Batang Yagit," to name two, turned out to be sleeper hits.

Going farther back, one can cite how "Roberta" in 1951 starring super screen tot Tessie Agana made mothers and their kids

cry buckets, making the film such a huge hit that it saved Sampaguita Pictures from bankruptcy.

Regis Films and Entertainment, Inc. intends to revive that trend with its maiden offering called "Tatlong Bibe." Make no mistake about it. "Tatlong Bibe" may bear the catchy title of a novelty song that went viral a few seasons back ,but the Joven Tan-directed movie does not feature anything whimsical like children growing wings like real ducks.

"Tatlong Bibe," says its director, is a tearjerker that revolves around three kids played by child actors Raikko Matteo, Lyca Gairanod, and Marco Masa.
